【About Sinking Bridge】

The Shimanto River's sunken bridges are bridges without railings that are designed to be submerged in the river when the river floods.
The scenery of the green mountains, the blue Shimanto, and the sunken bridges is perhaps the most typical of the Shimanto River.
The closest sunken bridge to the river mouth is the Sada (Imanari) sunken bridge, and it feels so good to cross it.
In addition, just within the main Shimanto River basin (within Shimanto City), there are the Sanri, Takase, Katsuma, Kuchiyauchi, Iwama, Chosei, Nakahanya, and Hanya sunken bridges, all of which offer a view that is typical of the Shimanto River and that gives a sense of the relationship between the river and people.
